

Thrive and Learn Care (TLC) Program at Newfield Elementary School Information and Fees

The Newfield Thrive and Learn Care Group (TLC) is a self-sustaining, school-sponsored program for 3-4 year old children. The program is located in the Newfield Elementary School. The TLC Group is available to residents of the Newfield Community. Non-residents' children may also attend. Children must be enrolled into the program. This is not a drop-in childcare program.

The Program operates Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM until 12:00 PM. Children must be 3 by December 1st to attend the program. A full curriculum is offered and includes free play, activity centers, singing, calendar activities, outside activities and lunch. Children attending TLC may also be part of the After-School Child Care Program, extending to a full day with the addition of a half day of care from 12pm to 6pm at an additional cost (see below).
