- 2 large boxes of tissues

- A small pair of scissors (Fiskars type works well)
- 3-4 glue sticks

- Large container Clorox, Lysol, Target, or Walmart Brand Disinfectant Wipes (must be these brands to meet school OSHA mandates)
- A container to hold your supplies

➤ There are a few items that you will need to bring on the first day of school:

• Please remember to label everything with a permanent marker (all supplies, coats, boots, gloves etc. — even pencils)

• We will put your child's extra pencils in a cupboard so they are available when needed.

• Third graders go through supplies quickly so it is good to check a month throughout the school year to see what your child needs. School supplies tend to be cheaper during back-to-school sales. You may want to buy extras during these sales and put them aside for later in the year.

➤ Please note that large notebooks and Trapper Keepers will not fit in the student's desks so they will not need these.

We are looking forward to meeting all of you. During the summer you will want to have your child practice their addition and subtraction facts to 20 — the better they know these the more quickly we will be able to move along in the fall. And always, the more reading they can do over the summer the better.

SUPPLY LIST – GRADE 4

- 1 clipboard
- 2 spiral notebooks - 70 page, wide-ruled
- 1 zippered pouch or small pencil box
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 pair child-safe scissors (Fiskars are best)
- 2 dozen #2 pencils - not mechanical- Ticonderoga brand is preferred – no label required
- 1 pkg. cap erasers
- 1 small box crayons
- 1 small set colored pencils
- 5 heavy weight pocket folders
- 1 pack of glue sticks
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 package of 4 black whiteboard markers
- 2 big tubs of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 pad of post-it notes (3" x 3")
- 1 backpack or book bag - no wheels
- 1 lunch bag or lunch money

Optional: Scotch tape and washable markers (These come in handy for a variety of projects)

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school, and make sure everything is **labeled with names!** We will be organizing our binders **together** on the first day of school, so please be sure to have your supplies with you.

- *4 dozen #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) Your child will likely need more mid-year.
- **1 Large 3-ring zippered binder**
Some of the ones that hold up best are: Pro Platinum, Case It and Five Star
- *4 pkg. cap erasers
- *3 pkg. loose-leaf paper (**wide-ruled**)
- 6 glue sticks
- Student-sized scissors
- *2 boxes of **colored pencils** (or 1 large box)
- large pencil pouch (hole-punched to fit in binder)
- *2 yellow highlighters
- 6 **heavy-duty**, cardboard, pocket folders (hole-punched to fit in binders)
- 2 fine point, black **permanent** markers
- 1 package/set of fine point, low odor dry erase markers
- 2 packages lined, white 3x5 cards
- 1 composition book (the marble-looking covered, sewn kind)
- 1 large backpack (no rolling backpacks; these do not fit in the lockers)
- *4 large boxes of tissues (more likely needed mid-year)

Assignment pads will be provided by the school and given to students on the first day of school.

There are great sales throughout the summer, so shop early to **save!**
