- 2- Pocket folders please label with their names

 - 1-box of washable markers classic colors (Green only)
 - 1- box of colored pencils, 24 count
 - 10- glue sticks (Green and Olmstead only)
 - 2- good quality pink erasers not pencil top erasers
 - 1- composition book (Green and Olmstead only)
 - 1- standard pencil box- large enough to hold 24 crayons, 2 glue sticks, pencils and erasers.
 - 1- large durable backpack- needs to be sent daily. No "wheeled" models
 - 2- large boxes of tissues

• Please remember to label everything with a permanent marker (all supplies, coats, boots, gloves etc. - even pencils)

• Third graders go through supplies quickly so it is good to check once a month throughout the school year to see what your child needs. School supplies tend to be cheaper during back-to-school sales. You may want to buy extras during these sales and put them aside for later in the year.

➤ Please note that large notebooks and Trapper Keepers will not fit in the student's desks so they will not need these.

During the summer, you will want to have your child practice their addition and subtraction facts to 20 - the better they know these, the more quickly we will be able to move along in the fall. SUPPLY LIST – GRADE 4**

- 1 clipboard
- 1 spiral notebook - 70 page, wide-ruled
- 1 zippered pouch or small pencil box
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 pair child-safe scissors (Fiskars are best)
- 2 dozen #2 pencils - not mechanical- Ticonderoga brand is preferred – no label required
- 1 pkg. cap erasers
- 1 small box crayons
- 1 small set colored pencils
- 5 heavy weight pocket folders
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 package of 4 black whiteboard markers
- 2 big tubs of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 pair inexpensive headphones if you want your child to have their own
- 1 backpack or book bag - no wheels
- 1 lunch bag or lunch money

Optional: Scotch tape and washable markers (These come in handy for a variety of projects)

Fifth Grade Supply List 2017-2018**

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school, and make sure everything is labeled with names!

- *4 dozen #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) Your child will likely need more mid-year; please label with your child's name.
- *4 pkg. cap erasers
- *6 glue sticks
- *1 bottle of liquid glue
- *2 boxes of colored pencils (or 1 large box)
- *large pencil pouch
- *2 highlighters (No yellow, please; any other color is fine.)
- 2 heavy-duty pocket folders - no plastic or flimsy ones
- 2 fine point, black permanent markers
- *2 packages/sets of fine point, low odor dry erase markers
- *1 composition book (the marble-looking cover and pages sewn in kind)
- 1 large backpack (no rolling backpacks; these do not fit in the lockers)
- *4 large boxes of tissues (more likely needed mid-year)
- 3 canisters of Clorox Wipes or Lysol Wipes

*If you are willing to buy an extra item or 2 for students who do not bring supplies, this would be greatly appreciated. The items above with an asterisk are the ones typically needed at the start of the year or we tend to run out of these items. Also, we have mini-white boards for the students to use, and we run out of the fine-tip dry erase markers quickly! If you are willing to donate extras of any of these items, we would greatly appreciate it. Thanks! ☺
