<p>Physical Education: Students will not be changing for PE. There will be no use of locker rooms. PE classes will be held outside as much as possible. Students should be prepared by wearing shorts/pants/sweatpants on PE day (no skirts or dresses).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sneakers (lace up, no crocs, no sandals, no slides, no boots, no shoes) ● Outdoor clothing/accessories (jacket/sweatshirt/hoodie, hat, gloves, sunglasses, sunscreen) ● Extra Footwear/Socks (incase sneakers get muddy or wet) 	<p>Band: <i>(not all students)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Clarinet and Sax players - 2 boxes of reeds ● Brass players - 1 slide grease, 1 valve oil (Trombones also need slam spray) ● Percussionists - 1 stick bag and 2 pair snare sticks (required), 1 pair tympani and 1 pair hard rubber xylophone mallets (optional) ● All students - combination lock for instrument cabinet (no key locks), label for instrument case/stick bag ● Optional but HIGHLY recommended, especially for NYSSMA soloists - Smart Music subscription (downloaded at www.smartmusic.com - not available until September, \$30 a year)
