<p>English 9 (Mrs. Kozlowski)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Lots of writing utensils <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>#2 Pencils are always wise.</u> If you prefer pen (which isn't recommended for most assignments), pens may have blue or black ink only. ✓ One 3-ring binder <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ This may be shared with another class, but you'll need to bring it to class each day. It will need enough space to store materials from September through June in order to maintain organization and study for the midterm and final exams. ✓ Either a notebook OR loose-leaf paper to keep in your binder <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Paper is needed for note taking. ✓ Tab dividers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ These are necessary for separating major units of study and maintaining organization. ○ Use of hole-punched colored paper is fine to use instead – it just needs to be clear that you are staying organized and separating units of study in your binder ✓ Post-It Notes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Post-it notes are used for annotating texts – students are more successful with this method (optional) ✓ Highlighter(s) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Any color is fine (optional) ✓ Optional: USB Drive <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Since we do a lot of work on the computers with written pieces and projects, it's wise to have your own USB drive in order to save and store your work. ○ These are not a necessity as there are other means of saving work (Edmundo backpack, Google Drive, G-drive, etc.) ✓ Tissue box and pencil donations are always greatly appreciated, but certainly not necessary.
