## **HAROLD "PETE" SMITH AWARD**

The Board of Directors of the *Newfield Lions Club* has established an annual award in memory of **Harold "Pete" Smith**, who was President of the Club at the time of his death. The award will be \$150. to be awarded to a graduating senior.

Since service to others was a paramount concern of Pete, it was felt that this should be a guideline in setting the criteria. The following provisions will apply:

1. Participation by seniors is voluntary. An essay is to be written with no less than 500 words on a topic dealing with "***service to the community***".
2. The essay will be graded in two parts:
  - a. Up to 50 points for the essay itself;
  - b. Additional points to be added according to the writer's past history of service (points awarded for such things as student council member and/or class officer; and other service activities as listed on the application).
3. The award winner will be decided through an awards committee at the Newfield High School, consisting of a member of the Guidance Department, English Department, and the Advisor of Senior High Student Council.
4. In the event the award is not given for any particular year, two awards will be awarded the following year.
5. Examples of **Service Points**:
